CLASS 2 65cm (2ft-2ft 3ins) Approx. Horse or Pony. Rider any age

CLASS 3 75cm (2ft 6ins) Approx. Horse or Pony. Rider any age

Gipping Riding Society Regulations

- The organisers have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and stewards.
- The judge's decision is final. Any objections must be made in writing to the Show Secretary within 30minutes of the cause and be accompanied by a deposit refundable only if the objection is sustained.
- The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry or amend the schedule. The organisers will not tolerate disruptive behaviour from horses or riders.
- Gipping Riding Society shall not be liable for any claim in respect of damage, loss, injury or accident to any person, horse or property howsoever caused in connection with or arising out of this show. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the Gipping Riding Society or any person acting on their behalf against any legal action arising from such an incident.
- HAT REGULATIONS it is mandatory to wear a protective helmet manufactured to one of the minimum standards listed. It must bear the CE mark and a quality symbol. PAS 015:1998, or 2011 together with the BSI Kitemark. Snell E2001, with the official Snell label and number, AS/NZS 3838 1998, AS/NZS 3838 2003 or 2006 with the SAI Global symbol. VG1 with BSI kite mark. ASTM-F1163 2004a with SEI mark. The CE symbol on its own is not sufficient. Hats must be worn when mounted, with chin strap fastened at all times.
- We recommend the use of Back Protectors.
- All horses and ponies must 4 years old or over to compete.
- Do not obstruct the access- emergency services must have access to all parts of the event at all times.
